US-UK Defence Trade Co-operation Treaty

Industry Consultation 8 November 2011

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• Treaty requires movement of US Defense Articles to be within an Approved Community for the end-use of US or UK Governments



 Re-transfer or re-export to non-Approved Community entities in the UK or overseas considered only in exceptional circumstances

• UK Approved Community facility proposing to re-transfer or re-export Treaty items would need to put itself back to a position where it had US approval before seeking UK approval



- Where UK Approved Community facility proposes to re-transfer Treaty item to a non-Approved Community facility in the UK it must have:
- Written US Government approval
- Written UK Government approval (MOD Form 680)
- and adhere to protective security requirements



• Where a UK Approved Community facility proposes to re-export Treaty item to a non-Approved Community facility overseas it must have:

- Written US Government approval
- Written UK Government approval (F680)
- UK Export Licence

 and adhere to protective security requirements, including (F1686) if for sub-contracting, collaborating or teaming, and for the transmission of US classified material



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Arrangements will be detailed in Security Policy Framework amendment and a guidance note
