- \* Respondent: Robbins & Myers Belgium S.A., Chaineux, Belgium
- \* Charges:
  - Three charges of 15 C.F.R. § 764.2(a): Engaging in Prohibited Conduct by Reexporting Items for Power Sections Used in Oil and Gas Drilling and Exploration to Syria, without the Required Licenses
  - Four charges of 15 C.F.R. § 764.2(e): Acting with Knowledge of a Violation
- \* Fine or Civil Settlement: Civil Settlement of \$600,000
- \* Debarred or Suspended from Export Transactions: Not if penalty is paid as agreed.
- \* Result of Voluntary Self-Disclosure: No
- \* Date of Order: 7 October 2014
