- Control List Classification Service
- Advice Service for helping you prepare better applications for complex exports
- New online tools to help you classify goods and identify if you are eligible for an Open General Export Licence
- SPIRE replaced with LITE that will be integrated with the new HMRC CDS digital platform – this should negate the need for OGEL returns
